Keynote Speaker

Rev. Dr. Rick Vance, GCUMM Secretary

The Rev. Dr. Richard “Rick” Vance has served with the General Commission on United Methodist Men since 2016, joining as Director of the Center for Men’s Ministries and later becoming Director of Operations in 2021. In September 2025, he was appointed to his current leadership role with the Commission.

Dr. Vance began his professional career in healthcare and education, serving as a radiologic technologist, clinical supervisor, and instructor of radiologic sciences before entering ordained ministry. He earned his Bachelor of Science degree from Salisbury University, a Master of Divinity from Wesley Theological Seminary, and a Doctor of Ministry in Leadership Excellence. He was ordained an elder in the Peninsula-Delaware Annual Conference, where he served as a pastor and conference leader in United Methodist Men ministries.

Since joining the Commission, Dr. Vance has authored resources on leadership, discipleship, and gender-based violence prevention, and regularly leads workshops and conferences across the United States and internationally. He is widely known for speaking on spiritual gifts
